Location:            Coppercreek Camp, Greenville, CA 95947

Purpose: This event raises funds for the Rotary Club of Greenville and its community service projects. Proceeds support activities such as books for the community library, scholarships for students, maintenance of Rotary Park, and support for school vocational programs.

Trails: Keddie Ridge is the northern-most mountain ridge in the Sierra Nevada with fantastic scenery and hidden lakes. The ride will use existing roads and trails, some of which are rocky, on the Plumas and Lassen National Forests and on private forestlands. Elevations range from 3500 feet to 6500 feet.

Campsite: Coppercreek Camp is a private, family-owned and operated summer camp located in Greenville, CA. The camp is 2 hours from Lake Tahoe, 30 minutes from Lassen National Park, and about 5 hours from the San Francisco Bay Area. Coppercreek Camp has a large and diversified riding program so is well prepared to serve as the start/end point and campsite for this ride. The campsite area will be a large meadow area associated with the camp. NO ground fires are allowed. There is plenty of open space for all sizes of RVs, trailers, rigs, tents, panel or electric pens. **All dogs must be kept on a leash or confined!!!!**

Grocery stores, gas stations, and motels/B&Bs are available in Greenville, about 3 miles from camp.

Directions to Ride Camp: (Call 530-736-7601 for assistance along the way)

From the north:

SR-36 from Redding/SR-147 from Susanville, take SR-89 southbound toward Greenville; in Greenville turn left onto Main Street. Turn left onto Williams Valley Road. Turn left onto Upper Williams Valley Road and follow to the end. Follow signs into Coppercreek Camp. Follow staff directions for parking.

From the south:

SR-70 eastbound from Chico/SR-70 westbound from I-395-Nevada, take SR-89 northbound to Greenville. Turn right onto Main Street. Turn left onto Williams Valley Road. Turn left onto Upper Williams Valley Road and follow to the end. Follow signs into Coppercreek Camp. Follow staff directions for parking.

Junior Riders: AERC rules pertaining to junior riders apply to all distances. A junior rider is under 16 years old as of December 1, 2007. Junior riders **must** wear protective headgear and be accompanied by adult entrant.

Meals: For Friday dinner, Greenville has few commercial options. The dinner for Friday night will be prepared by a local charitable group at \$10.00 per person. The awards dinners on Saturday and Sunday nights are included for riders and available for guests at \$12.00 each.

## **Patriot's Day Endurance Ride Rules**

1. This ride will be governed by the AERC rules and regulations. All riders should be familiar and comply with such rules. A copy of the current AERC rules and regulations can be found at the AERC website: <http://www.aerc.org> and a copy will be at the ride.
2. There are no ties for any finishers. One prize only is available for first place.
3. All breeds of horse and mule are welcome. The animal must at least 5 years of age.
4. All animals will have a pre-ride and post-ride veterinary check. All veterinarians' decisions will be final regarding qualification of the animal.
5. Junior riders must remain with the sponsor throughout the ride. At no time is the junior ride to be out of the site or hearing range of the sponsor. Juniors are those who were under the age 16 as of 1 Dec 2007. The sponsor is to be an adult at least 21 years of age.
6. Juniors are required to wear a helmet. All adult riders are encouraged to wear a helmet.
7. Ride management reserves the right to remove or disqualify any person who is disruptive to the ride or endangers the safety of others.
8. All dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.
9. No campfires. No smoking on trails.
10. All animals must be "fit to continue" in order to receive a completion award.
